

During or after registration, select any/all North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) codes that apply to your business. Once registered, RAMP automatically emails notifications when bid opportunities are posted that match your chosen NAICS codes.

The Regional Alliance Marketplace for Procurement (RAMP) website will undergo enhancements and will be shutdown from December 9, 2024 to January 7, 2025. During this time, all contract opportunities will be suspended until the first quarter of 2025. Vendors will not be able to view solicitations on RAMP, complete their Business Inclusion Program (BIP) outreach, submit BIP Summary Sheets, or submit certification applications.
